The Hays County Dispute Resolution Center (DRC) is a non-profit organization that facilitates problem-solving for individuals and organizations in Hays County, Texas by providing, promoting, and teaching effective methods of conflict resolution.

Mediation is a process in which an impartial person facilitates communication between parties to promote reconciliation, settlement, or understanding among them, without imposing the mediator's own judgment on the issues.

Mediation is increasingly used by organizations, courts and governments as a more satisfying and effective means of resolving conflicts. In contrast to litigation, mediation is informal, cost-effective, confidential and time-efficient. Parties generally feel empowered and more satisfied with their agreements from mediation.

The mediator is essential to the process and facilitates the discussion by listening to the parties, encouraging communication, identifying interests, advancing the negotiation, and promoting the development of effective solutions.

About the Training

If you received your basic mediation training in a state other than Texas and would like to cover the topics in the Texas 40 hr. Basic Mediation Training curriculum established by the Texas Mediation Trainers Roundtable that deal specifically with Texas law, standards and ethics, this is the short course you are looking for. The Hays County DRC is offering a four hour short course covering these topics.

If the mediator training you received outside of Texas covered all the topics in the curriculum except Texas-specific material, this course will complete the credential requirements of the Texas Mediator Credentialing Association and the mediator training requirements pursuant to Chapter 154.052 (a) Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

The course covers material in the 40hr Basic Mediation Training curriculum relating to Texas ADR law and established Codes of Ethics and Standards of Practice in the field of mediation in Texas:

- Section I:** Review qualifications of the TEXAS ADR ACT For Impartial Third Parties
- Section II:** Overview of ADR Legislation in Texas
- Section III:** Detailed review of the ethical standards for mediation in Texas.
